

TOWN HALL, MILWAUKIE, OREGON, MAY 20TH. 1925.

A special meeting of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie was held on the 20th. day of May, 1925. Present, Mayor Cowell, Councilmen Kerr, McIntyre, Kelso and Hazen, Recorder Mathews and Marshal Keck.

The Mayor stated that the meeting was called for the purpose of canvassing the votes cast at the special election held on the 18th. day of May, 1925. The Council canvassed the returns of the special election held on the 18th. day of May, 1925, which returns were as follows:

A majority of votes having been cast for the amendment, upon motion duly made and carried, the Sewer Construction Amendment was duly declared adopted and carried and a part of the Charter and fundamental law of the Town of Milwaukie.

The following proposals were submitted for furnishing sand, gravel and cement for the construction of the base for stand pipe:

- Nottingham & Co. for sand and gravel..... \$2.90 per Cu. Yd.
- European Cement:.. \$3.10 per barrel.
- Hawthorne Rock Co. for sand and gravel... \$2.90 per Cu. yd.
- Milwaukie Warehouse Company, for European Cement. \$2.85 per barrel.
- Milwaukie Fuel & Feed Co. for sand & gravel.. \$2.70 per Cu. Yd.
- Oregon Cement at \$3.30 Rbl gross.
- 10¢ rebate on cement tax.
- 1% cash 30 days.
- G. C. Felton, for sand & gravel... \$2.65 per cu. yd.
- for cement 2.90 per ~~xxxxx~~ bbl.
- for European cement 2.70 per bbl.
- Would furnish the lumber for the protection of material, and would mix and pour in any proportion desired at \$1.45 per yd.

Upon motion duly made and carried, the Milwaukie Fuel & Feed Co. was awarded the contract for furnishing approximately 240 bbl of Oregon cement at \$2.90 per bbl. less 1% for cash in 30 days, and G. C. Felton was awarded the contract for furnishing approximately 75 yards of washed sand and 133 yards of washed gravel at \$2.65 per cubic yard. All the above material to be delivered on the job.

Upon motion duly made and carried, the Mayor and Recorder was instructed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Town of Milwaukie with Poole & McGonigle for the erection of steel stand pipe of 160,000 gallon capacity. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Recorder was instructed to advertise for bids for mixing and pouring the concrete for the foundation for the stand pipe, the bids to be opened on the 28th. day of May, 1925 at 8:00 o'clock P. M. of said day. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Council adjourned.
