**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE NOMINATION OF THE OREGON CITY TRAFFIC SIGNAL UPGRADES FOR THE 2020 ALL ROADS TRANSPORTATION SAFETY GRANT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, Oregon Department of Transportation is soliciting projects for the 2020 All Roads Transportation Safety (ARTS) Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the ARTS program is a competitive program with a focus on implementation of cost-effective and proven safety countermeasures; and

**WHEREAS**, the primary objective of the ARTS Program is to use a data driven approach to select the best projects to reduce fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads in the state; and

**WHEREAS**, a review of the crash data in Oregon City identified engineering opportunities to reduce fatalities and serious injury accidents at our signalized intersections; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to participate in the program and will commit to provide the indicated match should the project be awarded the requested grant funds; and



**NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**


