Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

A letter was read from the State Marine Board to Hal Schilling regarding the comprehensive six year marine facilities development plan.

The Riverfront area presently under City jurisdiction is 1.87 acres. Area under consideration (down to Pendleton) is _____ acres (as specified to Port of Portland for study)

Facility: Marina - need and comments.

It was the general concensus of the group that the City should acquire and develop an extensive marina.

The following motion was made by John Cook and seconded by Mr. Jones:

The Riverfront Committee recommends that Mr. Wilmot draft a statement incorporating ramps, docks (with the best floats possible), sewage pump-out stations, public restrooms, guest docks, gas docks, parking facility, facility for rowing teams, etc. for presentation to the State Marine Board.

Motion carried by unanimous vote.

There was discussion on long range plans - bike paths, widening of McLoughlin Blvd. to give more and better access to the riverfront.

Motion was made by Mrs. Savage that the South portion of the river where it curves past the sewage treatment plant up to Elk Rock Island be held in reserve for possible development by the City in conjunction with the proposed marina. Seconded by Mr. Cook. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Mr. Jones made a motion to recommend to the PARC that Kellogg Lake and the shoreline be designated as part of the Willamette Greenway in the Comprehensive Plan. Seconded by Mr. Cook. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Motion on future location of McLoughlin Blvd. tabled. Motion made by Mr. Cook, seconded by Mr. Jones. Motion carried.

It was suggested by Mrs. Savage that either overhead or underground path be considered to give access to pedestrian traffic across McLoughlin Blvd. to the river.

Suggested meeting dates to be Wednesday if at all possible.

Mrs. Savage to give riverfront report.

Meeting adjourned at 9:30 p.m.
