"A Bill for an act to amend the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in the County of Clackamas, in the State of Oregon, by enacting and providing an amendment to said Charter, providing for and authorizing said Town of Milwaukie to issue and dispose of \$25,000.00 additional water bonds for the purpose of completing the Full Run Water System and installing water meters for each consumer." Upon motion duly made and carried, the recorder was instructed to prepare an ordinance calling a special election to be held on the 21st day of August, 1915, and post a copy of the same as required by the city charter. Moved and seconded that the Council adjourn. Motion carried.

TOWN HALL MILWAUKIE, OREGON, JULY 28TH. 1915.

Water
A special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Milwaukie was held on the above named date. Meeting called to order by Mayor Pelton. The Mayor stated that the meeting was called for the purpose of considering the purchase of the Minthorn Springs Water System. Mr. Gibson, Receiver of the Minthorn Springs Water Company, was present and made several propositions to the Council for ascertaining the value of the Minthorn Springs Water Company's property, but the Council did not take any action in the matter.

Upon motion duly made and carried, the Recorder was instructed to advise the Portland Gas & Coke Company that the Council would take immediate action upon the dedication of the Scharner addition when the same was properly presented to the Council.

Upon motion of councilman Skulason seconded by councilman Counsell and carried, the recorder was instructed to notify the petitioners for Full Run water who live outside of City limits, that the Town has not the funds to lay water mains outside of the Town limits, but if they would lay their own main to the Town limits, the Town would be glad to furnish them with Full Run water. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Council adjourned.
