

MEETING OF FEBRUARY 16, 1962.

Mayor Clay appointed Roger Hollingsworth to serve on the Planning Commission to serve out the unexpired term of Arthur Martineau.

The regular meeting of the Milwaukie Planning^{Commission} was held on the sixteenth day of February, 1962

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Cecil Nickles.

Those present were Chairman Cecil Nickles; Commissioners Henry Stewart, Earl S. Burdick, Max Thompson, Marvin Shrock, Earl Clay, John O. Sheldahl, Leonard Mullan and Roger Hollingsworth.

Mr. Ed. Lucas appeared about Lots 3 and 4 Block 9 J.R.W. Sellwood Addition. He asked to have 10 feet of Hays Street, along the southwest side, thereof, vacated. He said he would like to build two duplexes. After a lengthy discussion it was decided to zone that part of Block 1 not now in the Industrial zone and the entire Blocks 8 and 9, J.R.W. Sellwood Addition as ~~2~~-R-2 SPECIAL zone.

Mr. J.R. Morrison appeared relative to a plat proposed, on Boss Lane. Attorney Sheldahl advised Mr. Morrison to clear the question as to who has title to Boss Lane, it has not been dedicated as a public way.

Don L. Moore asked if he could add a couple additional hutches for chinchilas, to those already on the property, in Rockwood Addition. After some discussion he decided not to do so at present.

Mr. John Corsey and Stan Federman appeared and spoke to the Commission relative to plans for City growth. They were briefed on the plans presently being considered and were appreciative of the work being done. They were also informed that the Planning Commission is setting the first Tuesday of each month as a special meeting of representatives from each organization and citizens groups, where ideas can be presented and discussed.

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
