ZC-67-13 IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Nase, seconded by Mr. Liddell, to recommend to the City Council that the zone change be approved. MOTION CARRIED unanimously and so ordered.

ZC-67-12 IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Kennedy, seconded by Mr. Eddy, to recommend that the zone change be denied. MOTION CARRIED unanimously and so ordered.

SP-67-16 IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Liddell, seconded by Mr. Englund, to approve the application for a special permit to change internally the existing building at 4411 S.E. Lake Road to become a duplex. MOTION CARRIED unanimously, and so ordered.

OTHER BUSINESS

A consideration for a street dedication - Applicant, Mrs. Alene Z. Croft

An application for a street dedication by deed was brought before the Commission for consideration, for the purpose of extending Lakeside Avenue to the southeast. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Nase, seconded by Mr. Kennedy, that the Planning Commission accept the street dedication subject to the agreement by the property owner to complete all improvement requirements of Ordinance No. 1157 upon demand of the City of Milwaukie and if the property owner fails to complete the improvements the City may complete said improvements and recover the full cost and expense of completing

said improvements. MOTION CARRIED unanimously and so ordered. The applicant requested that there be no requirement to provide the improvements at the time of dedication.

The agenda for the December 18 meeting of the Clackamas County Planning Commission was read. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Eddy, seconded by Mr. Liddell, to recommend denial. of the request for conditional use under Item No. 5, FCU-79-67 by Rose Villa, Inc. Mr. Englund abstained from voting; all others voted AYE. MOTION CARRIED and so The Secretary was instructed to so inform the Clackamas County Planning Commission by letter. The request was to build three duplexes on the southeast corner of River Road and Torbank Road.

As there was no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was duly adjourned at 11:05 p.m.
