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TOWN HALL, MILWAUKIE, OREGON, SEPT. 12TH, 1916.

The one hundred seventy-fourth (174) regular meeting of the Town Council was held on the above named date. Meeting called to order by Mayor Felton. Present, Mayor Felton, councilmen, Grasle, Miller, Shindler, Counsell and Snyder, Recorder Mathews, Treasurer Streib and Marshal Piley. The minutes of the regular meeting of the council held on the 8th day of August, 1916, and the minutes of the special meetings of the council held on the 16th and 23rd days of August, 1916, and on the 8th day of Sept. 1916, were read and approved as corrected. The bill of Mr. Loeding for the use of the his ground by the City and for connecting his house with bull run water was read and referred to Finance Committee. The bill of Mr. Skulason for connecting his house with bull run water was read and referred to Finance Committee. A communication from the P. R. L. & P. Co. in regard to an alleged balance due it from the City for lighting was read and referred to Mr. Miller for investigation. The petition of the property owners on 27th street asking the council to improve the same was read and referred back to the petitioners for correction. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Mayor was instructed to secure the services of an Engineer for the City. Upon motion duly made and carried, Ordinance No. 146, entitled, "An ordinance providing for the cutting of grass, thistles, cockle burrs and weeds on the real property in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon; repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, and declaring an emergency", was taken up for the first reading. The ordinance being read the roll call showed the following result: Ayes, Grasle, Snyder, Miller, Shindler and Counsell. Nays, none. Ordinance No. 146 passed the first reading. Upon motion duly made and carried, the rules were suspended and ordinance No. 146 was taken up for the second reading and read by title only. The roll call showed the following result: Ayes, Grasle, Snyder, Miller, Shindler and Counsell. Nays, none. Ordinance No. 146 passed the second reading. Upon motion duly made and carried, the rules were suspended and ordinance No. 146 was taken up for the third and final reading and read by title only. The roll call showed the following result: Ayes, Grasle, Snyder, Miller, Shindler and Counsell. Nays, none. Ordinance No. 146 passed. Upon motion duly made and carried, councilman Counsell and Marshal Piley were instructed to have the holes in the hard surface on Front Street repaired.
