MEETING OF OCTOBER 15, 1962

The regular meeting of the Milwaukie Planning Commission was held on the fifteenth day of October, 1962.

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Marvin Shrock.

Those present were Commissioners Marvin Shrock, Roger Hollingsworth, Cecil Nickles, Leonard Mullan, Max Thompson and Earl Clay. Absent: Chairman Earl Burdick and Commissioners John O. Sheldahl and Henry Stewart.

The minutes of the regular meeting of the Commission, held on the eighteenth day of September, 1962 were approved as read.

The minutes of a special meeting of the Commission, held on the second day of September, 1962, were approved as read.

The minutes of a special meeting of the Commission, held on the fifth day of October, 1962 were read and approved.

Mr. Mullan brought before the Commission the question of a roadway running south from Lake Road a distance of approximately 500 feet.

Mr. Mullan stated that the School District owned the land along the west side of the proposed road and that the School Board had assured him that they would give sixteen feet off the east side of their property and improve the same as a road provided that Mr. John Bosnjak would give a like amount off the west side of his property and improve the same as a public road. Mr. Bosnjak was present and stated that he would give and improve this part of the road, and requested the Commission to approve this proposed thirty-two foot road to be known as Shell Lane. The Commission agreed that if the improvement covered the entire width of the roadway (32 feet) it would be approved by the Commission and recommended to the Council. No motion was made.

Mr. Max Thompson explained to the Commission that where land in the City is being subdivided or platted, it is necessary that the different departments of the City have a copy of the plat, and requested that the Commission require that a minimum of four plats be furnished to the City. It was moved by Nickles and seconded by Hollingsworth that hereafter, the plattors or subdividers of land in the City be required to furnish a minimum of four copies of the plat or subdivision, to the City. Motion carried and so ordered.

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
