## SPECIAL MEETING OF JANUARY 3, 1951

A special meeting was held at the call of the Mayor on the third day of January, 1951

The meeting, which was called for the purpose of considering the acceptance of a deed for 34th Street from its intersection with Harrison Street, southerly a distance of about 300 feet, was called to order by Mayor Sperr.

Mr. Ralph Klein was sworn to his office of Councilman of Milwaukie and took his seat at the Council table.

Present: Mayor Sperr; Councilmen Norbeck and Klein. Manager Telford, Attorney Kirkpatrick and Recorder Martin. Absent: Councilman and Councilman-elect Leonard Mullan. Mr. F.C.Plummer was also present.

Mr. Plummer presented a deed for a street 50 feet wide, to run southerly from the south side of Harrison Street a distance of 300 feet.

Manager Telford reported that he had viewed the street, that there was 15 inch curbs in place but that at the intersection with Harrison Street there were no radius curbs, that the south 12 to 18 feet of the street had no rock on it at this time, that if the street is put in acceptable condition it will have to have a crown built up in the center line and eight inches of rock put in over most of the street, and in some places there was need of about ten inches of rock. The Council discussed with Mr. Plummer as to how the street was to be finished. On account of the wet weather at this time it was agreed that if a satisfactory guarantee could be given the Council, that the improvement would be made as soon as the weather permitted, that the Council would accept such guarantee. It was moved by Norbeck and seconded by Klein that the City accept the deed to 34th Street south of Harrison Street, a distance of 300 feet, subject to a letter from Portland Road & Driveway Co. to the effe ct that the street would be finished suita ble to the City's specifications as soon as the weather permits such completion. Motion carried and so ordered.

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
