The meeting was called for the purpose of a work session to interview applicants for the Planning Commission, and to consider measures to be placed on the ballot at elections.

Jerry Mesander and John Westley, applicants for appointment to the Planning Commission, were interviewed by the Council. Roy Osborne had notified the Council that he had a prior commitment and would be unable to attend the meeting, but was still interested in the appointment. The Mayor will announce the appointment at the next meeting.


There was discussion of a proposed bond measure for street and storm sewer. Rod Johnson made a presentation on behalf of the citizen committee. City Manager was directed to work with the committee to finalize the financial program, cost impact, and devise promotional information effort.

There was discussion of a proposed tax base measure. Irwin Adams made a presentation on behalf of the citizen committee. City Manager was directed to develop figures for a 1975-76 tax base.

There was discussion of proposed charter revision. There was no committee person present. City Manager was directed to confer with the citizen committee on revisions and bring back recommendations. Civil Service Commission input was requested. City Attorney was directed to research whether charter revision must be submitted during a general election or is a special election permissible.


City Manager briefed the Council on developments toward implementation of community survey.
