The meeting was called to order by Vice Chairman Marvin Shrock.

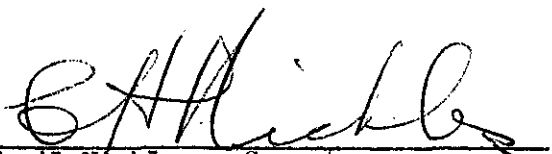

The minutes of the regular meeting of the Commission, held on the 15th day of September, 1959, were read and approved as read.

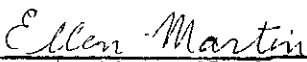
The minutes of a special meeting of the Commission, held on the 16th day of October, 1959, were read and approved as read.

The Chairman opened the hearing on the question of a change of zone for the Miller Tract, between Harrison and Monroe Streets. It was shown that proper notice of the hearing had been given. The Chairman called for any objection or remonstrance to this change of zone. There was no citizen present who made objection and no written objection had been filed. The Chairman declared the hearing closed.. It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Clay that the Commission recommend to the City Council that the property known as the Miller Tract, lying south of Harrison Street, east of the Tillamook Branch, R.R., north of Monroe Street and west of Spring Creek, be changed from Zone 3R-1 to Commercial Zone. The motion was carried and so ordered.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, upon motion duly made and carried, the meeting adjourned.
