MEETING OF "COMMITTEE FOR CITY PLANNING"

Those present were: Joseph M. Bernard, Jr., Theron Sedgwick, Charles Renard, Walter Freeman, Robert Richmond, Paul Baer, Roger Hollingsworth, Cecil Nickles, W. Henry Stewart, Dave Strauss and Max Thompson.

The meeting was called to order by Roger Hollingsworth at 8:00 P.M.

A motion was made by Robert Richmond and seconded by W. Henry Stewart to recommend to the Planning Commission the adoption of the attached resolution to cover area in which future applications to Commercial Zone will be considered. Motion carried.

Motion adopted by Committee for City Planning recommends that applications for zone changes to commercial be considered only the in the following area:

That area bounded to the west by the present "Downtown Milwaukee" commercial zone, South along Lake Road to 27th., Along 27th. North to Washington Street, East on Washington Street to Olive, Northeast along Olive and projected in a straight line to Monroe Street, East along Monroe Street to 44th., North along 44th. to King Road, west on King Road to 40th., South on 40th to Harrison, West along Harrison to 34th., North on 34th., to Llewellyn Street, West on Llewellyn to 32nd., North on 32nd to Meek Street, West along Meek Street and in a projected straight line to the point where a projected 22nd Street would intersect. North along this projected 22nd Street 110.15 feet, Then West along the line of property designated as Industrial to Main Street.

A motion by W. Henry Stewart and seconded by Theron Sedgwick to recommend that the Planning Commission recommend to the City Council that they modify Commercial Zone ordinances to implement action taken by the Planning Commission in regards to future commercial areas. Motion carried.
