

SPECIAL MEETING OF PLANNING COMMISSION
AND CITY COUNCIL, JULY 9, 1952

A special joint meeting of the Planning Commission and the City Council was held on the 9th day of July, 1952.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Williams

Present: Chairman Williams, Commissioners Nickles, Martin, Kirkpatrick, Clay and Swaggerty, Mayor Sperr, Councilmen Norbeck, Klein and Mullan.

This meeting was called at the request of Mr. Jones, representing the County Court. He brought up the matter of the adoption of a uniform numbering system for Clackamas County.

After much discussion Mr. Jones reminded the Members of the Commission that there were two ways the numbering could be done.


- 1, Extend the City of Portland numbering system into Clackamas County.
2. Use Oregon City as a starting point and number Clackamas County separately.

He stated that the County was willing to undertake the work and stand the expense of the job, but they wanted to do it in accordance with the wishes of the various Planning Commissions who have jurisdiction.

Mr. Jones requested that the members of the Planning Commission and the City Council along with the Mayor and City Engineer, attend a joint meeting of the Planning Commissions of Clackamas County, to be held in the County Court House in about ten days or two weeks.

Chairman Williams requested all members of the Planning Commission to meet Friday, July eleventh at one o'clock P.M. at the City Hall for the purpose of visiting the Portland Gravel Company's plant in a body. *Gravel Co*

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
