

SPECIAL MEETING OF JULY 29, 1957

A special meeting of the Milwaukie Planning Commission was held on the 29th day of July, 1957, for the purpose of a hearing on a change of Zone for lots 8,9,10 Block 2 Leo Addition.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stewart.

Present: Chairman Stewart; Commissioners Sedgwick, Shrock, Nickles, and Burdick. Absent: Commissioners Perkins, Swaggerty, Scott, Mullan and Sheldahl. Councilman Klein was also present.


The public notice of the hearing as published in the Milwaukie Review, was read. chairman Stewart called for any objection or protest to the change of Zone from Industrial to Commercial for Lots 8,9,10, Block 2 Leo Addition. There was no objection or protest. It was moved by Nickles and seconded by Sedgwick that the hearing be closed and that since there was no objection to the change of zone, that the Commission convene in executive session to make recommendation to the Council. Motion carried and so ordered. The Chairman declared the hearing closed.

The room was cleared, and the Commission convened in executive session.

Chairman Stewart called the meeting to order.

It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Shrock that the Planning Commission recommend to the Council that the zone for Lots 8,9,10, Block 2 Leo Addition be changed from Industrial Zone to Commercial Zone. Motion carried and so ordered.

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
