

SPECIAL MEETING OF JUNE 3, 1960

The Planning Commission of the City of Milwaukie held a special meeting, for the purpose of a hearing on a zone change for Block 2, Streib's Addition, on the third day of June 1960.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Marvin Shrock.

Present: Chairman Shrock; Commissioners Nickles, Mullan, Stewart, Clay, Burdick, Thompson ~~and Ellen Martin~~. Absent: Commissioners Martineau and Sheldahl and Ellen Martin.

Chairman Shrock opened the hearing on the change of Zone from 3R-1 to Commercial Zone for Block 2, Streib's Addition, and called for protest or objection to the same. It was shown that proper notice of the hearing had been published and posted. There was no citizen present who made objection to the change and no written objection had been received. It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Stewart that the Planning Commission recommend to the City Council that Block 2, Streib's Addition be changed from 3R-1 to Commercial Zone. Motion carried and was so ordered.

There being no further business to come before the Commission at this time, on motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
