

## **COUNCIL RESOLUTION No. 44-2021**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE KRONBERG PARK MULTI-USE WALKWAY.

**WHEREAS**, the city recognizes that sections of the Kronberg Park Multi-Use Walkway are within ODOT right-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**; the city needs to ensure that the giant sequoia tree adjacent to Oregon Highway 99E will be protected and preserved; and

**WHEREAS**; the Kronberg Park Multi-Use Walkway is part of the city's Safe Access for Everyone (SAFE) Program, which provides safe spaces for active transportation incentivize transportation modes that are less carbon intensive; and

**WHEREAS**, the ConnectOregon grant used to fund a significant portion of the project requires the city to enter into a maintenance agreement with the state.

**Now, Therefore, be it Resolved** by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that the city manager is authorized to sign an intergovernmental agreement between the city and ODOT that outlines the respective maintenance responsibilities for the Kronberg Park Multi-Use Walkway.
