

COUNCIL RESOLUTION No. 50-2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ACTING AS THE LOCAL CONTRACT REVIEW BOARD, APPROVING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE 42ND AVENUE/43RD AVENUE SAFE/SSMP IMPROVEMENTS (CIP-2018-S16/CIP-2020-A10) TO TAPANI, INC.

WHEREAS, the city's fiscal year 2021-2026 Capital Improvement Plan identified the 42nd Avenue SAFE Improvements and the 43rd Avenue Safe Access for Everyone (SAFE)/Street Surface Maintenance Program (SSMP) Improvements projects as priorities to improve pavement infrastructure, sanitary sewer infrastructure, and pedestrian access facilities; and

WHEREAS, resources to construct these improvements were identified within the city's 2021-2022 biennium budget; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie engineering department determined combining the two improvements into one contract was in the city's best interest; and


WHEREAS, a formal competitive bid process following Public Contracting Rule 40 was completed; and

WHEREAS, Tapani, Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

Now, Therefore, be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that the city manager is authorized to execute a contract with Tapani, Inc. for construction of the 42nd Avenue/43rd Avenue SAFE/SSMP Improvements project, to waive any irregularities, and the city engineer or assistant city engineer is authorized to administer the project in accordance with the project specifications with a project authorization of \$3,034,000.00.

Introduced and adopted by the City Council on September 21, 2021.


