¹⁾ The contractor for the Public Works Operations Complex incurred additional project expenses due to COVID-19 pandemic monitoring, additional landscaping requirements and unforseen conditions and code requirements. These costs will put the project overbudget approximately \$90,000. An additional \$60,000 is requested to address acoustic issues within the building and a fuel management system upgrade. This budget adjustment reallocates contingency to cover the additional cost.
