## **PROCLAMATION**

- **Whereas**, public works professionals focus on infrastructure, facilities, emergency management, and services that are of vital importance to sustainable and resilient communities and to the public health, high quality of life, and well-being of the people of Oregon City; and
- **Bhereas**, these infrastructures, facilities, and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of public works professionals who are engineers, managers, and employees at all levels of government and the private sector, who are responsible for rebuilding, improving, and protecting our nation's transportation, water supply, water treatment and solid waste systems, public buildings, and other structures and facilities essential for our citizens; and
- **Bhereas**, it is in the public interest for the citizens, civic leaders, and children in Oregon City to gain knowledge and maintain interest and understanding of the importance of public works and public works programs in their respective communities; and
- **Bhereas**, the efficiency of the qualified and dedicated personnel who staff the Oregon City Public Works Department is materially influenced by the people's understanding of the importance of the work they perform; and
- Whereas, National Public Works Week was instituted in 1960 by the American Public Works Association to call attention to the importance of public works in community life, and the United States Senate passed a resolution affirming the first National Public Works Week; and
- **Bhereas**, the year 2022 marks the 62<sup>nd</sup> annual National Public Works Week and it should be recognized with the theme "Ready and Resilient."
