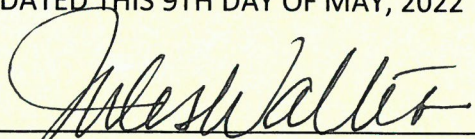
WHEREAS, our police department has grown to be a modern and scientific law enforcement agency which unceasingly provides a vital public service.

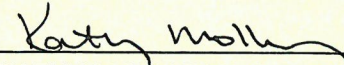
NATIONAL POLICE WEEK
