A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE NOMINATION OF THE HOLCOMB BOULEVARD SIDEWALK AND PROTECTED CROSSING SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT FOR THE 2022 SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE FUNDING GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Oregon Department of Transportation is soliciting for projects for the 2022 Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Infrastructure Funding Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Holcomb Boulevard Sidewalk and Protected Crossing Project will remove some of the existing barriers for students who walk, bike, and roll to Holcomb Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, Holcomb Elementary has 50.9% of students identified as low income; and

WHEREAS, many areas along Holcomb Boulevard lack safe pedestrian crossings, sidewalks, and bike lanes which prevents students from walking and biking to school; and

WHEREAS, we are pleased to support the City's application for the 2022 Safe Routes to School Infrastructure Funding Grant Program which will help resolve some gaps in safe roadway, pedestrian, and bicyclist infrastructure.

NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Staff is authorized to submit to the Oregon Department of Transportation for the 2022 Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Infrastructure Funding Grant Program for the Holcomb Boulevard Sidewalk and Protected Crossing Project.

Section 2. This resolution becomes effective upon adoption.
