DISCUSSION ITEM

1. Request to Demolish Abandoned Structure on Urban Renewal Property Near Clackamette Cove

James Graham, Economic Development Manager, explained that the structure had been vacant for some time, and that it had been vandalized by trespassers. C & R Reforestation has offered a quote of \$9885.00 to demolish the building and clear resultant debris with the exception of the structure's cement base.

Commissioner O'Donnell asked how many quotes had been received for the project. Mr. Graham explained that three quotes had been received. Commissioner McGriff inquired regarding the building's original use, which nobody present could recall.

Motion made by Commissioner McGriff, seconded by Commissioner Smith, to approve the request to demolish the structure on the Urban Renewal property at 16400 Main Street near Clackamette Cove. The motion passed by the following vote:

Yea: 5 – Commissioner McGriff, Commissioner Cross, Commissioner Marl, Commissioner O'Donnell, Commissioner Smith


COMMUNICATIONS
