WHEREAS, staff will be in the community handing out thank-you buttons at surprise locations to honor our residents for their continued support of the Library; and




in West Linn, Oregon, and call upon all residents of this great city to join me in supporting the mission and vision and heightening the awareness of the importance of our libraries.
