REPORTS

Milwaukie Police Department

Cpt. Ryan Burdick noted there were 2 officers recently sworn into the MPD, 1 female & 1 male officer. The hiring process is lengthy. The department is currently reviewing contracts with Motorola for the purchase of body cameras. There was a "Coffee with Cops" event recently at the Milwaukie Star Buck's. It was a success and helps promote good communication with the department and provides the public an opportunity to ask questions to the MPD. Cpt. Burdick noted auto thefts have always been a big problem in the Portland Metro area. He mentioned there have been recent car thefts and break-ins in some areas of Milwaukie. He encouraged citizens to contact the non-emergency telephone number to notify the MPD of any suspicious activity.

TREASURER

PSAC

Christine Giatti who was recently elected as our PSAC Representative, gave a report to our NDA for the first time. She noted that pavement and landscaping on the Lake Road Improvement Project will be done throughout October.
